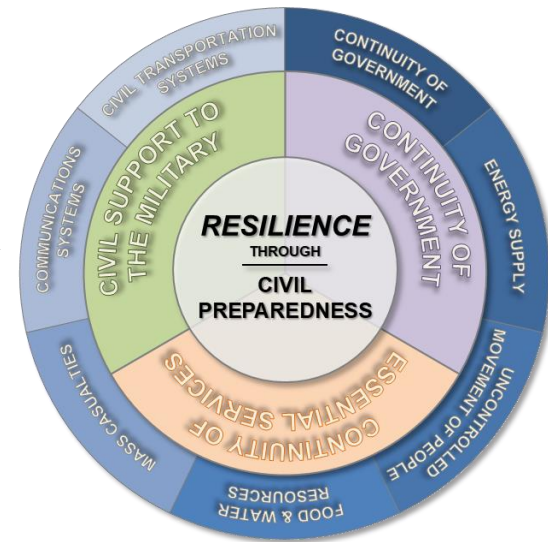
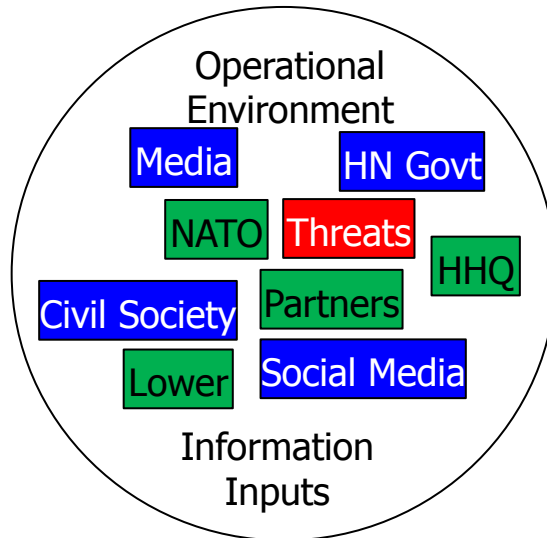
Unified Action - synchronization, coordination, and integration of the activities of governmental and nongovernmental entities to achieve unity of effort.
